

2019 Plumas Underburn Cooperative Dutch Oven Cook-Off Entry Form

Thank you for your interest in participating in the Dutch Oven Cook-Off to support the Plumas Underburn Cooperative! This citizen-based group is focused on using fire to promote healthy forests and safe communities.

The event will be held Sunday, **March 24th** from noon to 2:00pm at the Meadow Valley Fire Station. There will be live music, beer on tap, and information about wildfire risks and resources. **Entry fees will be split 50/50 between the cook-off champion and the Plumas Underburn Cooperative.**

Ground Rules:

1. Cooks provide the Dutch oven. Any size can be used, but the more servings the better. Because this is the first year of the event, we don't know how many people to anticipate. The winner will be determined by "peoples' choice" so you'll want to have enough for as many people (votes) as possible.
2. Cooks can arrive as early as 9:00am to use coals from burn piles to heat/cook the food. Food must be ready and setup by 12:00pm.
3. Cooks are responsible for serving utensils. Plumas Underburn Cooperative will provide a table, canopy, bowls, cutlery, and napkins.
4. Electricity will not be provided.
