Plumas County Fire Safe Council Meeting 11/9/17

Plumas County has experienced a tremendous year of fire activity. At the Fire Safe Council's regular meetings, Plumas National Forest and CAL FIRE have been providing updates on the fires that have kept them busy. Despite the changing weather, they're not done yet. In fact, they're never done - when crews are not actively containing flames, the focus is on prevention activities. At the Plumas County Fire Safe Council we have partnered with these two agencies to tackle hazardous fuels reduction projects around communities as part of the prevention effort.

The Plumas County Fire Safe Council currently has funding for five project areas, totaling over 1,000 acres of fuels reduction treatments. Interested parties can learn more about these projects and other fire-safe initiatives at the next meeting of the Plumas County Fire Safe Council on Thursday, November 9th, 2017 from 9:00 am to 11:00 am at the Plumas County Planning & Building Services office, 555 Main Street in Quincy. Council meetings are held on the second Thursday of each month and are attended by citizens, business owners, and representatives from local, state, and federal government agencies, who share a common interest in preventing loss of life and minimizing loss of property from wildland fires.
