FINANCIAL QUALIFACTIONS:

Inspection and contract coordination is free of charge to all those meeting the above age/disability qualifications. PC FSC has developed a co-pay formula for any contracted work to be done on an applicant's property based on an applicant's adjusted gross income. The co-payment is based on contractor bids that are no more than \$1,500.

- Property must not currently meet California Public Resource Code 4291 that requires a MINIMUM of 30 foot clearance of all flammable materials (needles, dry grass, brush, etc.) around the house and fuel reduction from 30-100 feet (or to the property line) from the house as well.
- All non-vegetative human debris must be cleaned up prior requesting assistance from the Plumas County Fire Safe Council.
